In our next issue, I hope we will be able to share some great stories from our experiences on the trip!

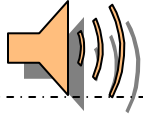

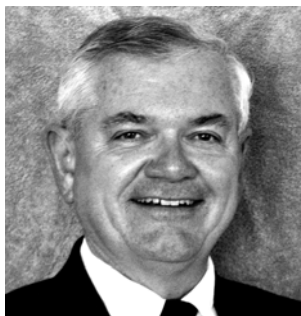
